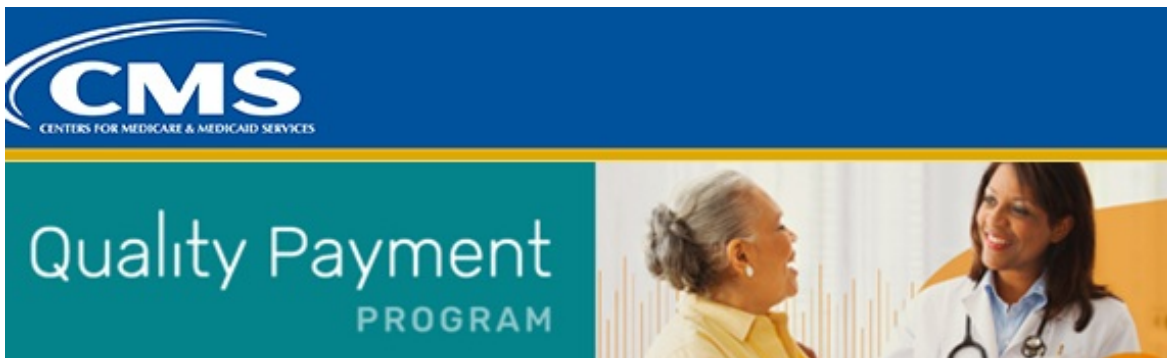

Now Available: 2022 MIPS Performance Feedback, 2022 MIPS Final Score, and 2024 MIPS Payment Adjustment Information



The Centers for Medicare & Medicare Services (CMS) has released Merit-based

Incentive Payment System (MIPS) performance feedback and final scores for the 2022 performance year and associated MIPS payment adjustment information for the 2024 payment year.

You can view your 2022 MIPS performance feedback, including your final score and 2024 payment adjustment on the [Quality Payment Program \(QPP\) website](#).

- [Sign in](#) using your Health Care Quality Information Systems (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) system credentials; these are the same credentials that allowed you to submit your 2022 MIPS data.
- Click "View Feedback" on the home page.
- Select your organization (Practice, Alternative Payment Model (APM) Entity, Virtual Group).
  - Practice representatives can access both individual and group feedback.

If you don't have a HARP account or QPP role, please refer to the Register for a HARP Account (re: HARP account) and Connect to an Organization (re: QPP role) documents in the [QPP Access User Guide \(ZIP, 4MB\)](#) and start the process now.

## Stop Losing Your Money!

### Hospitals

Are you in compliance with Promoting Interoperability?

### Clinicians

Are you in compliance with the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS)?

*Only eligible hospitals and CAHs can participate in the Medicare Promoting Interoperability Program while Medicare eligible clinicians can participate in QPP including MIPS.*



For *hospitals*, Payment adjustment is applied as a reduction to the applicable percentage increase to the IPPS payment rate, and CAH will be reduced from 101 percent of its reasonable cost to a lower specified rate.

For *clinicians*, failure to report may result in a **9% negative** payment adjustment on your Medicare reimbursement.
